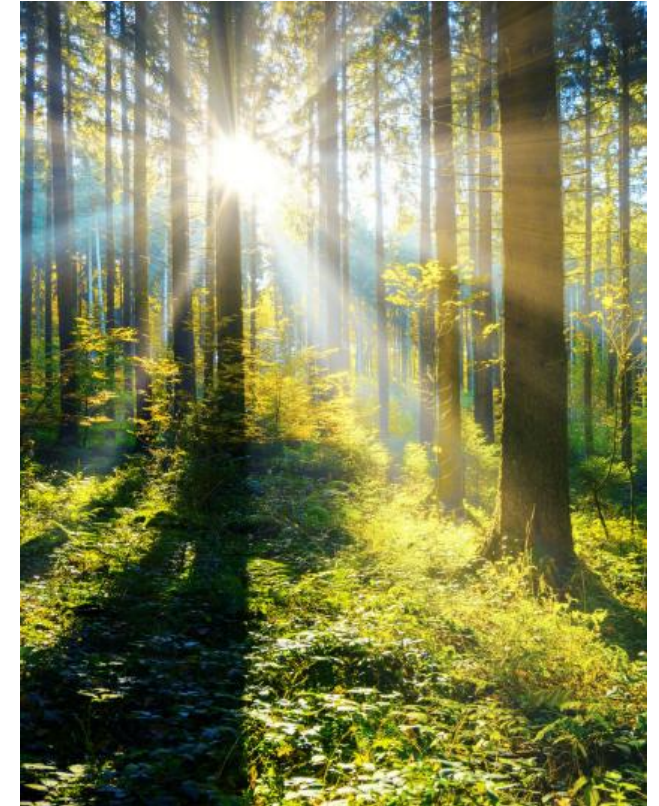

# What is Required?

---

- ✓ Minimum of 100 forested acres
- ✓ Must own timber rights
- ✓ No overly restrictive easements
- ✓ Must enroll all eligible forest ownership
- ✓ Provide periodic access to FCW team and forest technicians
- ✓ Payment period 25 years
- ✓ Monitoring period 35 years



# During Payment Period (25-50 years)

---

\$10/acre/year or 25% revenue share option

Can extend payments from 25 up to 50 years

Forest certification managed by FCW

10% of carbon set aside for climate-smart forestry

Annual survey completed online

Access to licensed regional foresters





# During Monitoring Period (35 years)

---

Additional harvest flexibility

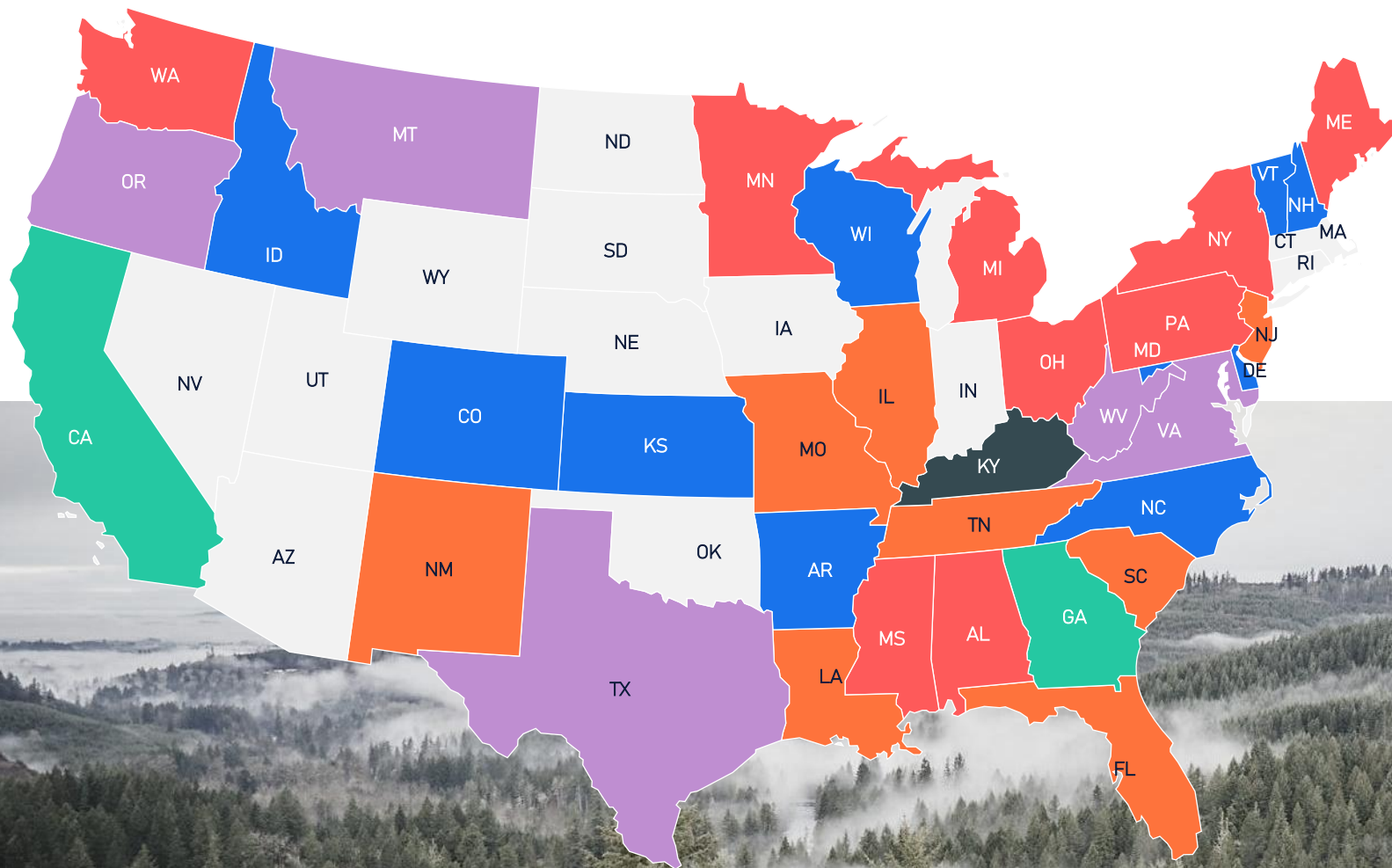
Forest certification not required

Annual survey not required

# FCW Harvest Policy

---

- Goal: to promote long term carbon storage, forest health, and climate resilience
- 10% Uncredited Reserve Stock (URS)
  - Allows for uneven and even-aged Rx's
- Customized Offers
- No limitation on forested covertime
- Harvest buckets
  - Commercial vs non-commercial
- All harvest activity is reviewed and approved by FCW staff

Type: Non-commercial

Location: Oregon

Rx: Third row pine  
thinning and HWD  
harvest

Type: Commercial

Location: Alabama

Property Acres:  
1,811





# Carbon Measurements & Quantification

---

- On-the ground inventory: traditional forest inventory with additional precision
- Stratify similar forests
- Volume based on species, diameter, height

Tree measurements

Volume

Biomass

Carbon

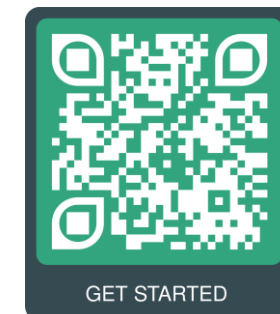
