Barry County 4-H Advisory Council Grants Grant Request Information

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Overview

Barry County 4-H Advisory Council has decided to make grants available to 4-H Clubs utilizing our funds. While a fair is a very educational event, these funds are not intended for fair supplies or expenses. Awards are given at the Council's discretion.

Application Criteria

Applications will be accepted for up to \$500 for 4-H clubs annually as long as funding is available. 4-H members and leaders must work as a team to develop and submit the educational plan for funding. Examples would include but are not limited to learning clinics, speakers and other educational events brought into your club or county. Trips to events are not included but could be reimbursed under our scholarship program.

Grant Criteria

The Barry County 4-H Advisory Council may grant funds for projects and activities that will provide for or enhance the educational experiences of Barry County 4-H Youth. Such grants will be made at the discretion of the 4-H Council in cooperation with 4-H staff. Efforts will be made to accommodate first time grant writers. No application will be accepted without the club or charter club EIN number. The youth, accompanied by a leader will be asked to be present at an Advisory Council meeting to speak about their project prior to the money being awarded. The Advisory Council will then vote and respond with a decision within 7 days.

Grant Process

Forms to request a "grant" are available at the MSU Extension Office. Grant requests must be submitted to the Extension Office and will be reviewed at the next scheduled Advisory Council meeting.

Grant Payments

A condition of any grant is that the Grant Evaluation must be completed and filed with the Extension Office not more than two weeks after the completion of the timeline defined in the grant request. Grants will receive 75% of the funds in advance of the project startup and 25% upon completion and approval of the Grant Evaluation. Funds must be used within one year of being received.
