

## Living in a Family Project – Guidelines

Living in a Family notebooks are defined as a popular leisure activity that involves a very creative preservation and display of photographs, news clippings, certificates, etc. in a notebook form.

Preservation of photos, news clippings, etc. is done by placing items on acid-free paper using photo mounts, photo corners or glue and adding accessories whether it is by pens, stickers, etc. Although it is not required, it is recommended that acid-free materials be used.

<b>Age Groups</b>	<b>Minimum pgs Required</b>
9-11 years old	10
12-14 years old	12
15-19 years old	16

### General Requirements:

- Neatness
- Creativity – including use of stickers, die cuts, cropped photos, etc.
- Journalizing – brief summary of page or events
- Notebook is not limited to photos. Include ribbons, certificates, news clippings, etc.
- Title page – with name, age, year & theme
- Minimum of 10 pages (depends on age group)
- Pages can be a minimum of 4x6 to a maximum of 12x15 in size.
- Must be in a binder (3 ring, post, hinged) large enough to accommodate the paper size.

Sports	Christmas
Vacation	Specific Sport
Growing Up	Family Reunion
Pets	My Cat

Be creative on your choice of theme.

These are **only guidelines**. Member’s project should be based on skill and experience.
