BAE Masters – Program Change</p> <p>#15 General program description – the structure of the PhD program description was actually more understandable; suggest adopting it for MS A and B degrees.</p> <p>Under the additional requirements for a Plan A Master:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * #2 is a nearly incomprehensible run-on sentence. * List the requirements in order of occurrence. Complete credits, then prepare a thesis, then Submit a manuscript to a journal, then defend the thesis and take an oral exam. <p>Under the additional requirements for a Plan B Masters:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Clarify exam structure. Do Plan B students take a written exam, oral exam, or both? * If the Plan B report is 'nearly similar' to a thesis, then it's a thesis. Clarify that students prepare a report based on a project related to their Plan B. * as with the Plan A, list the requirements in order of occurrence. <p>Note: the terms guidance and graduate committee are interchanged throughout the document, decide on which to use so students aren't confused.</p>
