- One (1) educational requirement with proof by document, certification, day of event flyer.
(Acceptable examples: clinics, jackpot show, YQCA/BQA feedlot, Ag Career Night, FFA class, etc.)

Please note that educational videos are not acceptable for meeting this requirement.
