

4-H KEY CLUB AWARD

Eaton County 4-H Youth Programs

The Key Club Award is presented to older 4-H members whose leaders feel they have made significant contributions and achievements in 4-H. This award is intended to be the top county 4-H honor. In order to be nominated for a Key Club Award, members must meet the following criteria:

- A. Must have reached 15 years of age by the beginning of the club year (October 1 of the previous year).
- B. Completed three years in 4-H club work by January 1 of current year.
- C. Completed 4-H projects in at least two different project areas.
- D. Completed a teen leadership project.
- E. Participated in three State sponsored or State 4-H events.
- F. Been recommended by local leader.
- G. Past winners are not eligible.

To nominate a member, give them the attached application along with this form **with your signature**. Members must return their completed application along with this signed form to the Extension Office or emailed to gottjess@msu.edu by **December 20th**. The awards will be made at the Participation Recognition Celebration.
