The payouts are as follows:
 - \$600.00 -steers
 - o \$400.00 -swine and prospects
 - o \$200.00 -sheep
 - o Up to \$100.00 -small animal

 Simrau and seconded by Trista Harrell
 - State Horse Show Norma Maxwell Donation
