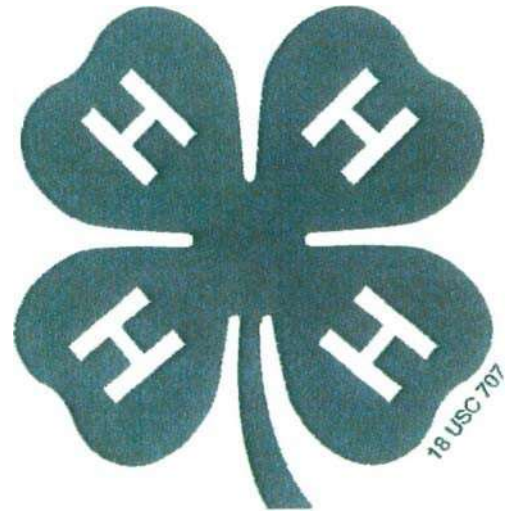

# Flag Pledges

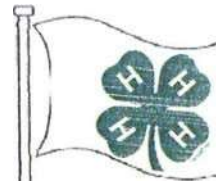


## The American Flag Pledge:

*(Arms at sides)*



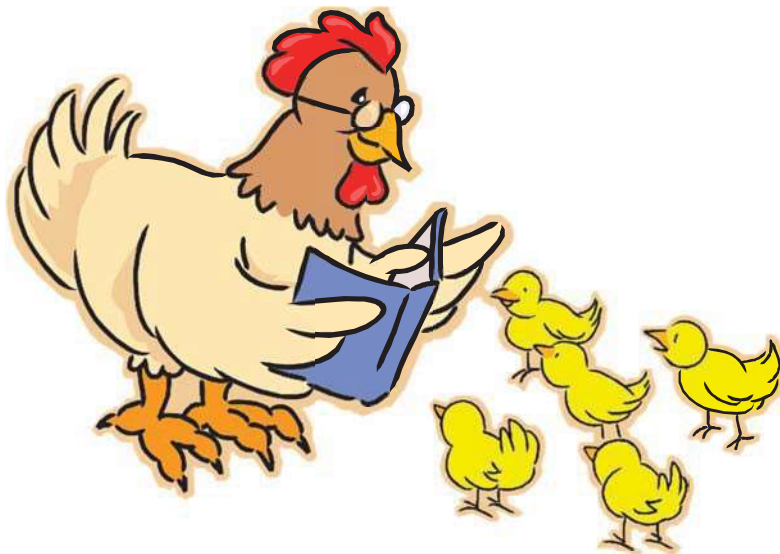
**My Health** to better living for my club, my community, my country, and my world.

## Objectives of the 4-H Cloverbud Poultry Project

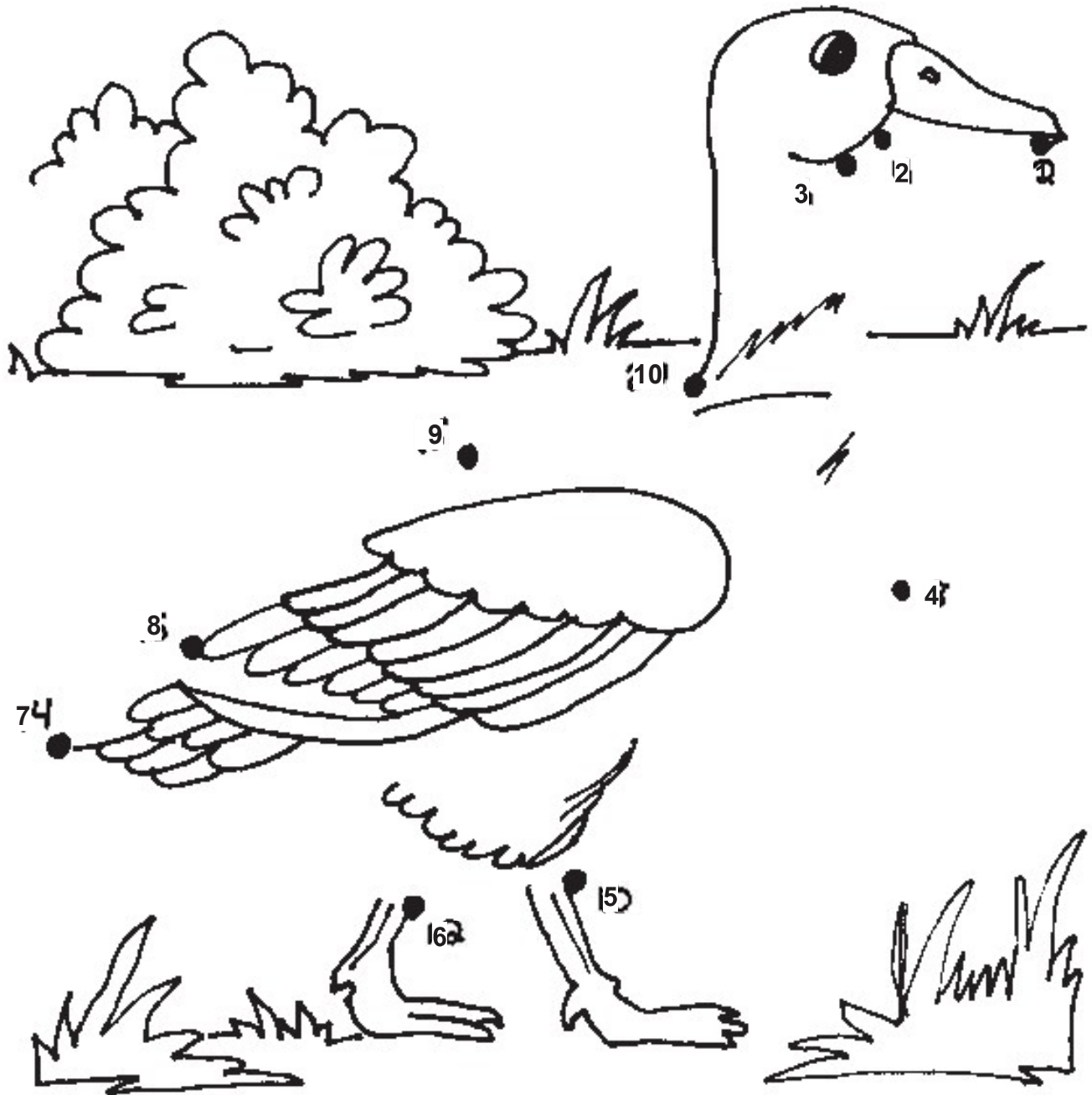
1. To gain experience caring for poultry.

This year I want to learn these things about poultry:

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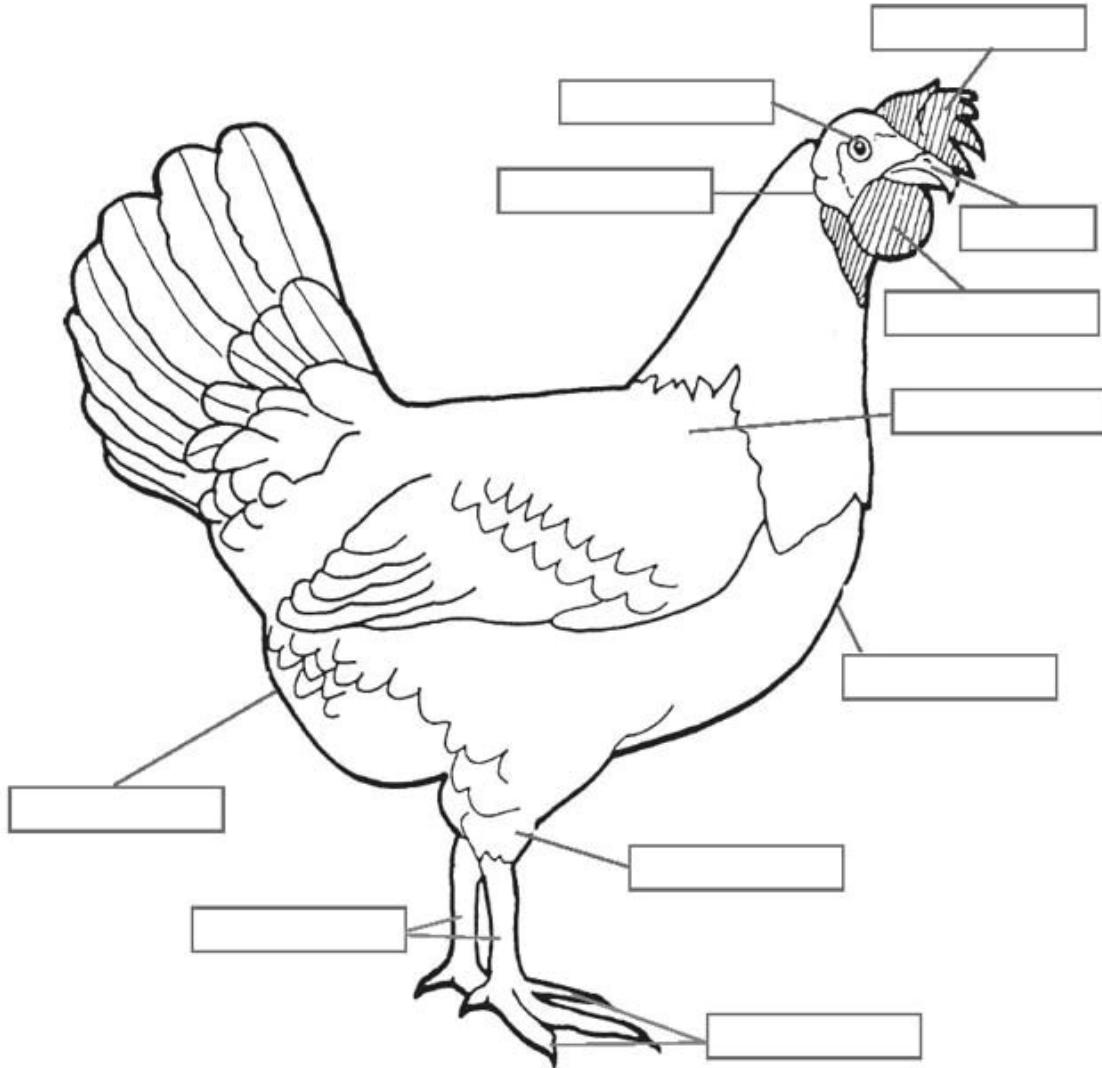

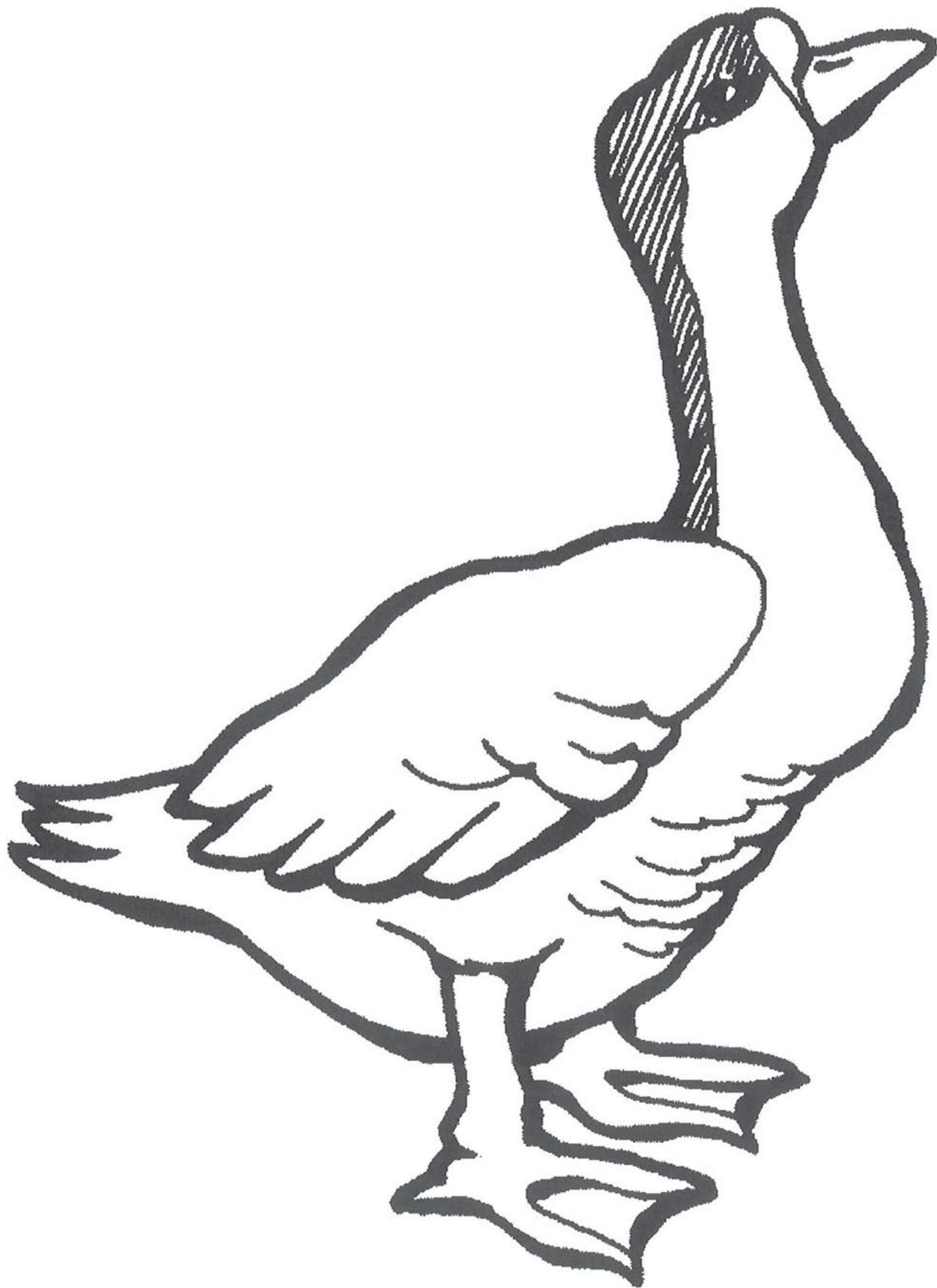
