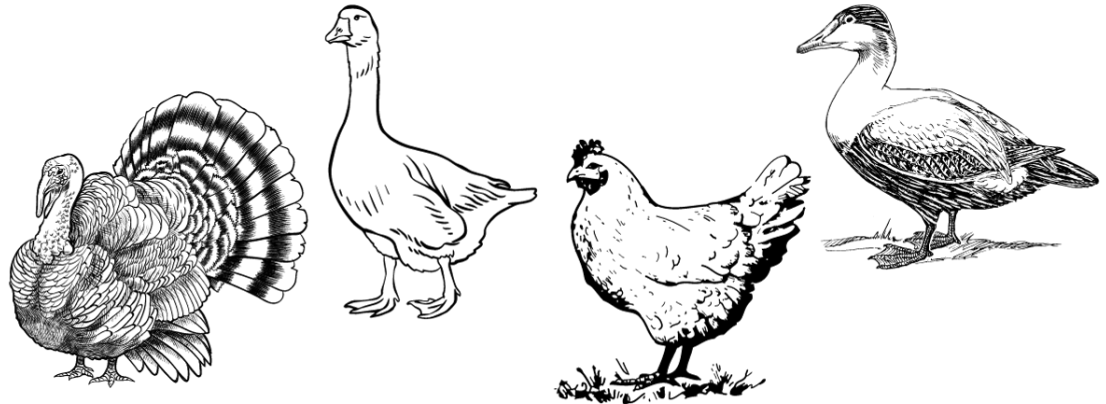

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## **EDUCATIONAL SECTION**

This section is to be done on a separate sheet of paper typed or written neatly.

Juniors (1-2 years in project): Choose ONE disease OR parasite and tell the symptoms, cure and any preventative measures you can take. You must do a different disease or parasite each year you are a junior.

Intermediate (3-5 years in project): Choose ONE disease AND a parasite and tell symptoms, cure and any preventative measures you can take. This must be a different disease and parasite for each year and different from your junior years also.

Senior (more than 5 years in project): Choose TWO diseases and parasites BUT they can be from previous years, but you must be more in-depth.

## **ANATOMY**

Juniors (1-2 years in project) – label 12 parts of your bird

Intermediate (3-5 years in project) – label 15 parts of your bird

Seniors (more than 5 years in the project) – label 20 + parts of your bird
