## Participate in the World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute

As millions across the globe deal with food insecurity, the World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute (WFP MIYI) offers young people an opportunity to be part of the solution. Held May 7 in East Lansing, or by participating from anywhere else using Zoom video/web conference technology, the event seeks to inspire and prepare the next generation of global leaders to end world hunger.

To participate, youth should be in grades 7-12 and register by the March 15 deadline. As part of the registration process, youth are required to prepare a three- to five-page research paper about a developing country and one of 22 key factors that affect food security. At the event, youth present and discuss their papers with other attendees and research and industry experts.

The top performing students at the WFP MIYI will be selected to attend the World Food Prize Global Youth Institute in Des Moines, Iowa, in October. For more information, visit <https://www.canr.msu.edu/wfpmiyi>. Registration opens February 1 and closes March 15.

Tip-off for the game is scheduled for 12 p.m. Gates to the Breslin will open at 10:30 a.m., with a variety of pre-game activities hosted by MSU Extension professionals around the concourse. Participants are encouraged to show their pride and wear green and white 4-H or MSU Extension apparel. Families for whom cost is a barrier should contact their local 4-H program coordinator.


### Get Involved in Shaping the Lapeer County 4-H Program!

# TEENS AS TEACHERS

## HEALTH LIVING PROGRAM

The Michigan 4-H Teens as Teachers Healthy Living Program seeks teens who want to take an active role in promoting health, wellness, and leadership within their communities.

The program empowers teens to serve as peer educators and role models who help younger youth make informed, healthy choices while developing their own character, confidence, and leadership skills.

Through the Teens as Teachers program, teens will receive leadership and facilitation training that prepares them to lead 4-H Healthy Living programs focused on:

- Mental health and emotional wellness
- Physical fitness and healthy lifestyles
- Substance use prevention and positive decision-making

Teens will receive a variety of benefits through their participation in the program, including:

- A scholarship to attend [Michigan 4-H Exploration Days](#) on the campus of Michigan State University (valued at \$250)
- A \$100 stipend after teaching their first lessons
- An official "Teens as Teachers" Shirt
- Materials and supplies to use while teaching
- Increased leadership and careers skills that can be used on application for scholarships, higher education, and jobs

The Teens as Teachers program is open to all Michigan youth ages 13-19 (no previous experience with 4-H is needed) and there is no cost to participate, but space is limited.

Working with other teen teachers in their community, and with continued guidance and support from 4-H staff, Teen Teachers will plan and lead educational workshops focused on healthy living for peers and younger youth.

Teen Teachers will continue to meet at least once per month from July-December for additional training and support. Meetings will be via Zoom with options for in-person, local gatherings with other Teen Teachers and 4-H staff.

Make these growing crystal hearts for Valentine's Day using just a few supplies!

### Supplies:

- 2 cups boiling water
- 6 to 8 tablespoons Borax
- Dowel or craft stick
- Pipe cleaner
- String

**The Science:** Hot water is able to hold more Borax than cold water because heated water molecules move farther apart. This extra space allows the Borax crystals to dissolve in the hot water. As the water cools, the water molecules move closer together again, which causes the larger crystals to form on the pipe cleaner and along the sides of the cup.

**Trick:** The Borax water solution can be used over again. Just pour the water and the crystals inside the glass into a pan and bring the water to a boil again. The crystals will dissolve into the water, and you can place new shapes in the solution.

## PIPE CLEANER ROSE RING

All you need are pipe cleaners to create these adorable rose rings! This craft project allows you to make charming rose rings that are perfect for surprising your favorite person on Valentine's Day. With just a few twists and turns, you can design a beautiful, personalized gift.

## SNOW VOLCANO SCIENCE EXPERIMENT



This snow volcano is an EPIC winter science experiment that allows kids to make a beautiful volcano right in the snow! As a bonus it is simple to set-up and quick to clean-up and leaves lots of color in your backyard too!

Combine:

- About 2 tablespoons dish soap
- Food coloring (optional – but why wouldn't you!)
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup baking soda

Start by putting these ingredients in a plastic cup or container. Mix the ingredients. HINT: If you want your snow volcano to propel up use a container with a narrow top.

Set the cup or container in the snow. Push snow around the cup so you can't see the cup anymore. Form the snow into a traditional looking volcano with the top open.

Pour vinegar through the top opening into the cup and stand back and watch the beautiful chemical reaction that occurs when baking soda and vinegar mix!




## HEART ORIGAMI BOOKMARK



1. Take a sheet of red paper and cut off the top section 3.5 inches down. You will have a piece of paper that is the width of the sheet and 3.5 inches tall.
2. Fold the piece of paper in half lengthways so you now have a longer, thinner sheet of paper.
3. Fold it in half widthways, crease down the fold line, then unfold. Use this center fold line as a marker and fold the two ends of the paper upwards to meet that line, creating two diagonal folds.
4. Turn the paper over and fold down the top 2cm of the ends of the paper at the top. Then fold the corners down to create the heart shape.
5. Turn the heart over again and stick two wiggle eyes to the front and draw a smile underneath with a black pen.




