Macomb County 4-H Club Leaders:

The new 4-H program year is here, and it's time to enroll/re-enroll your club for 2026-2027! Materials and the information you need to get started are listed below and are available online at <https://www.canr.msu.edu/macomb/4-h/club-resources/>. New clubs click on "[New Club Registration](#)" and re-enrolling clubs click on "[Returning Club Registration](#)."

Club enrollment/re-enrollment packet materials will be posted on the Macomb County 4-H web page by Sept. 1 or will be mailed from the MSU Extension 4-H office upon request. Please return completed materials by mail to Macomb County MSU Extension, Attn: 4-H, 21885 Dunham Road, Suite 12, Clinton Township, MI 48036 or by email to macomb.4h@macombgov.org so that we may update your club information in the 4-H Online enrollment system **before** your club members and volunteers enroll in 4-H Online.

2026 Year-End Information

Required year-end report: Club and committee leaders, don't forget to turn in your group's [Annual Financial Summary Report \(AFSR\)](#) for the previous program year (Sept. 1, 2025-Aug. 31, 2026). An AFSR is required annually from each 4-H club and committee. There are separate forms for clubs/committees **without funds** and clubs/committees **with funds** and **SPIN Clubs**. Completed forms may be mailed to Macomb County MSU Extension, Attn: 4-H, 21885 Dunham Road, Suite 12, Clinton Township, MI 48036; emailed to Macomb.4h@macombgov.org; or turned in with your club's 2027 club enrollment/re-enrollment materials **no later than October 1, 2025**.

4-H SPIN clubs with funds must complete a [4-H SPIN Club Record of Finances](#) instead of an Annual Financial Summary Report. SPIN club leaders should consult the local 4-H staff about this (Rebecca Konarski, konars13@msu.edu or 586-783-8163 or Lizz Duran, duraneli@msu.edu or 586-469-6090).

Club disbandment: If your club is *not* returning for the 2026-2027 program year, please contact the Macomb County 4-H program staff for important information about the required [club disbandment process](#).

2027 Club Enrollment/Re-enrollment Information

Club enrollment/re-enrollment for the 2027 program year begins September 1, 2026. Leaders, please turn in your club's enrollment materials to Macomb County MSU Extension so that MSU Extension can update your club information **before** your youth members and screened adult volunteers enroll/re-enroll via 4-H Online. The [4-H Online](#) enrollment system will open for 2027 member and volunteer enrollment on September 3, 2026. NOTE: Members and volunteers may not be able to enroll in a club for 2026-2027 until required forms for their club have been submitted to MSU Extension.

2027 MEMBER and VOLUNTEER Enrollment/Re-enrollment:

Youth members and screened adult 4-H volunteers may begin enrolling/re-enrolling online at <https://mi.4honline.com> beginning September 3, 2026. Please use the [4-H Online Family Guide](#) for instructions or contact the Macomb County 4-H Office at 586-469-6431 or macomb.4h@macombgov.org for guidance. **NOTE: Members and volunteers may only be able to enroll/re-enroll with a club after the club has registered for 2027 and MSU Extension has updated the club's information in 4-H Online.**

Unable to enroll online? Contact the Macomb County 4-H Office for assistance. MSU Extension has printed [youth member enrollment forms](#) and 4-H approved [volunteer enrollment forms](#) available. These forms have been updated for 2026-2027. **Please do not use old forms.**

4-H Enrollment/Re-enrollment Reminders

It's important to remember that:

- Youths planning to show 4-H livestock projects at the 2027 Armada Fair must be registered 4-H members by Jan. 1, 2027. Youths planning to show 4-H non-livestock projects at the 2027 Armada Fair must be registered 4-H members by April 1, 2027. Macomb County 4-H youth members who do not plan to show 4-H projects at the 2027 Armada Fair may enroll in 4-H at any time during the current 4-H program year, before they participate in 4-H meetings, events and/or activities. Please be aware that some clubs also have member enrollment deadlines for their clubs.
- Clubs must have at least two screened gold-level volunteers and five youth from two or more families. There must be at least one screened volunteer registered for every eight youth.
- All bank account statements should be sent to the Macomb County MSU Extension office each month.
- At least two (2) approved meeting minutes and treasurer's reports should be sent to the County 4-H Office during the 2027 4-H program year. The address is Macomb County MSU Extension, Attn: 4-H, 21885 Dunham Road, Suite 12, Clinton Township, MI 48036. The fax number is 586-469-6948, Attn: 4-H; and the email address is macomb.4h@macombgov.org.
- Clubs/committees must submit a [Fundraiser Application](#) to the County 4-H office at least two weeks before a club fundraiser and a [Fundraising Report](#) no later than two weeks after the club fundraiser.
- A copy of the sign-in sheet for each workshop, training or community service activity your club does should be submitted to Macomb County MSU Extension.
- Administrative club leaders should be [monitoring their club rosters](#) and inform Macomb County 4-H staff when their clubs are full and no longer accepting members. Staff will then turn off the 4-H Online enrollment option for those clubs.
