- Stalls are to be stripped within 1 1/2 hours after completion of last classes on Saturday and all horses out of the barn. Barn will be closed and locked 1-1/2 hours after last classes.
- Aisles, including center aisle, must be kept clear.
- Miniature Horse (38 inches and under) and Small Ponies (38-46 inches) are eligible for Mini classes.
- Payment by cash or check only.
