

HOW TO FILE A CIVIL RIGHTS COMPLAINT

Michigan State University prohibits discrimination and harassment in its programs based on age. color, gender, gender identity, disability status, height, marital status, national origin, political persuasion, race, religion, sexual orientation, veteran status, or weight. MSU also prohibits retaliation against those who report discrimination or harassment, or who participate in the University's investigation and handling of such reports.

If you believe you have been discriminated against or harassed in an MSU Extension program or activity, you are encouraged to report the incident to the MSU Office of Civil Rights, MSU Extension, the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), or all three.

U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

File a complaint with the U.S. Department of Agriculture using either the USDA Program Discrimination Complaint Form (AD-3027) or a letter. The form is available online (https://www.usda.gov/sites/default/ files/documents/ad-3027.pdf). from any USDA office, or by phone (866-632-9992).



A complaint letter must contain all of the information requested in the form (including the complainant's name, address, and phone number, the date of the alleged discriminatory action, and a written description of the incident) and be signed by the complainant or their authorized representative.
