Otsego County 4-H Trail Riding Program

Who Can Participate:

Current 4-H Horse Members, 4-H Horse Leaders, 4-H Horse Member's Parents/Youth Siblings (Siblings must be 5 by January 1 of the current 4-H year.)

Registrations / Time Frame:

There is no cost to participate, however registrations must be received by May 1 for year end awards.

The Trail Riding Program will run September 1 - August 1.

IMPORTANT PROGRAM GUIDELINES:

1. This trail riding program will commence on September 1.

Registrations will be accepted until May 1.

- 2. Riders must log the time they spent in <u>actual active trail riding</u> (riding on the trail...in actual trail riding...on actual riding trails...<u>no show hours, no arena/lesson hours, not in paddocks or around barns, etc.</u> Deduct the time you are off your horse for breaks or just sitting on your horse "hanging out". On a side note, please give your horse adequate time to rest on a long trail ride.
- 3. Riders will record time spent trail riding, horse ridden, location of ride, who you rode with, obstacles or challenges encountered on trails, gaits ridden, and if you wore a certified riding helmet.

NOTE: The horse ridden does not need to be the member's project horse, You can ride different horses for the trail rides.

- 4. 4-H Member's Leader or a Parent must sign all youth log pages to verify hours before submitting.
- 5. In order to receive awards, all signed youth and adult log pages must be submitted by August 1.
- 6. 4-H helmet guidelines must be followed in order to participate in this program. Helmets required for all 5-8 year olds and *strongly recommended* for all youth and adults.
- 9. Have a fun and safe year of trail riding!!!
