In 1956 the Village of Lake Success took over the golf course and rebuilt it which is known today as Lake Success Golf Club.

The Village dedicated well over \$20 million in the past several years on construction of its new clubhouse, new pro shop building, course drainage and irrigation systems. In the summer of 2018, the Village committed to a new superintendent with expectations to revitalize and modernize the course and all related to it. Completed projects include XDG installation on greens, strategic tree removal, complete rebuilding of the Course's signature 8th hole, extensive reconstruction of several tee boxes and bunkers, greens extensions, installation of two practice greens, reconstruction of driving range field, installed fertigation, and currently building a one acre short-game facility. Recently, the Village is contemplating a comprehensive bunker renovation with famed McDonald Design Group starting in the Fall of 2023.
