All areas must be completed for Consideration

To be eligible for the scholarship consideration, youth must:

- ✓ Be a high school senior or college freshman
- ✓ Verification of high school grade point average
- ✓ Be a current Shiawassee County Youth Exhibitor
- ✓ Have exhibited large market animals at the Shiawassee County Fair
- ✓ Have proof of acceptance into a college or trade school

To apply for the scholarship, youth must:

- ✓ Complete the JLA scholarship form. If typed, nothing smaller than 12 point font.
- ✓ You must utilize only the space provided. Pages cannot be added, unless typed.
- ✓ Submit at least 1 letter of recommendations from non-related persons such as pastor, teacher, employer, 4-H leader, FFA advisor.
- ✓ Submit all application materials by **May 1st, 2025**

The selection committee will:

- ✓ Carefully review your application and all attachments.
- ✓ Decide whether or not to set up personal interviews
- ✓ The Awards Committee, selected by the Shiawassee County Junior Livestock Association, will select the scholarship recipient or recipients.
- ✓ Present the scholarship at the Shiawassee County Fair.

If you are selected to receive the scholarship:

- ✓ Present proof of acceptance into a college or trade/technical school.
- ✓ The scholarship money will be awarded upon the recipient's entrance into college. The money will be in the form of a check made payable to the scholarship recipient and the college of his or her choice.
