Shiawassee County Small Animal Association Scholarship

The Shiawassee County Small Animal Association (SCSAA) will present 1 to 4 scholarships to eligible recipients. The award amount will be at least \$250 to each youth who is currently showing at the Shiawassee County Fair as a Small Animal Exhibitor under 4-H member. (The award amounts will be at the committee's discretion.)

The scholarship is designed to help youth further their education and pursue a career of their choosing after high school. The scholarship can be used to attend any 4-year institution, 2-year college or trade school of the member's choice. This scholarship is not based on a minimum GPA nor is it income based. It is a non-renewable award.

To be eligible to apply for the scholarship, youth must:

- ◆ Be a current and in good standing Shiawassee County Small Animal Exhibitor as a 4-H Member.
- Be a high school senior or in your first 2 years of college.
- ♦ Have proof of acceptance into a college or trade school.
- ◆ Have exhibited Small Animal Market Projects at the Shiawassee County Fair for at least 3 years

To apply for the scholarship, you must:

- Complete the SCSAA scholarship form. If typed, nothing small than 12-point font.
- ♦ You must utilize only the space provided. Pages cannot be added.
- ◆ Submit at least two letters of recommendation from non-related persons such as a pastor, teacher, employer, 4-H leader, FFA advisor or 4-H Program Coordinator.
- Include proof of acceptance letter to a college or trade school.
- ♦ Submit all application materials by May 1st to SCSAA, 149 E. Corunna Ave. Corunna, Mi 48817 or wheel297@msu.edu

The Shiawassee County Small Animal Association will:

- Carefully review your application and all attachments.
- ♦ Consider references provided.
- Select scholarship recipient or recipients.
- Present the scholarship at the auction.

If you are selected to receive the scholarship:

- ◆ You must submit one of the following items: a receipt of payment for tuition, books, board, class schedule or student ID.
- ♦ When we receive proof, then your check will be issued and sent to you.
