Discipline Rules: The [NRA BB Gun Rule Book](#) shall govern, unless otherwise specified in this program.

Discipline Specific Safety Rules: All firearms must be transported to the range in a proper case; one firearm per case. No firearm will be removed from the case until directed to do so by the range officer. Clear barrel indicators (CBIs) are required. Eye protection is required. A match official may disqualify any competitor for violation of the rules or for other conduct they consider discreditable or unsafe (Rule 9.24).

Entries: Competitors may enter multiple BB Gun events. Team entries will consist of three members.

Age Divisions: Beginner (Ages 9-11), Junior (Ages 12-14), Senior (Ages 15-19). Age determination date is 1/1/2026.

Gun: Any shoulder held smoothbore BB gun with metallic sights, in which the propelling force is developed through the use of a compressed spring, gas or compressed air. No alterations of factory manufactured BB guns may be made except as provided in the rules (Rule 3.1).

BBs: Only round .177 (4.5mm) lead or steel BBs are permitted (Rule 3.17).

Sights: Telescopic sight systems are prohibited. See Rule 3.7 *Sights*.

Equipment: See *Section 3 Equipment and Ammunition*.

Target: [Orion BB Gun 12 Bull Competition Target - 5m](#) (AR 4/10)

Distance: 5 meters (16 feet 4 3/4 inches) (Rule 6.4)

	5 minutes	Changeover
	3 minutes	Preparation period (non-firing)
