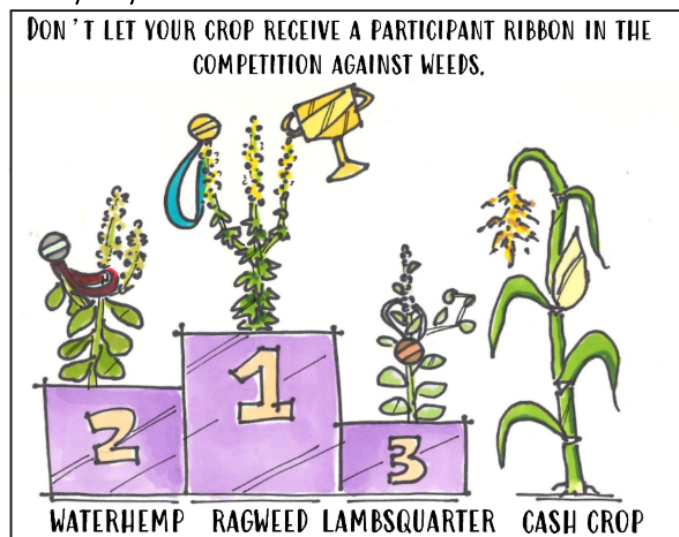

FREE Soybean Oil Content Testing - Only 3 kits left!

If you're still running beans and would like an opportunity to test your oil content for free, contact me (Nicolle Ritchie at 269-858-8739 or ritchi67@msu.edu)! All you have to do is collect a 2 lb sample of soybeans, put them in the provided mailer, and send them off. No postage required. Results will be returned to you later this year, probably around December. This is part of an ongoing project with the University of Minnesota. They will ask for your variety and a couple of other crop details, and they use this information to map oil content in soybeans based on variety and location. I have 3 kits left and would like them all to be used this year, so if you're interested, let me know!

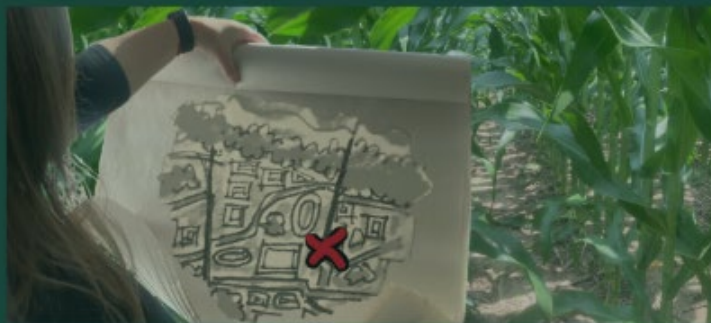

Farming Funnies

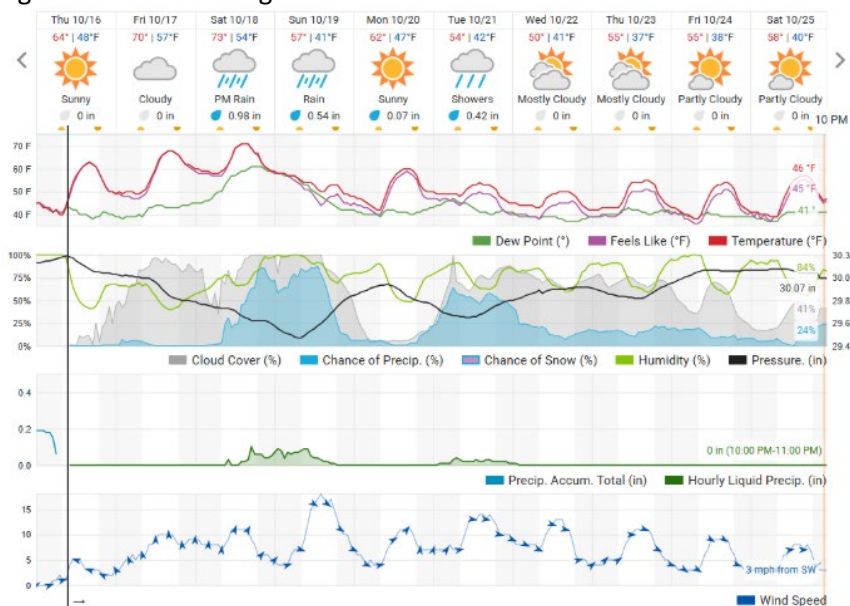

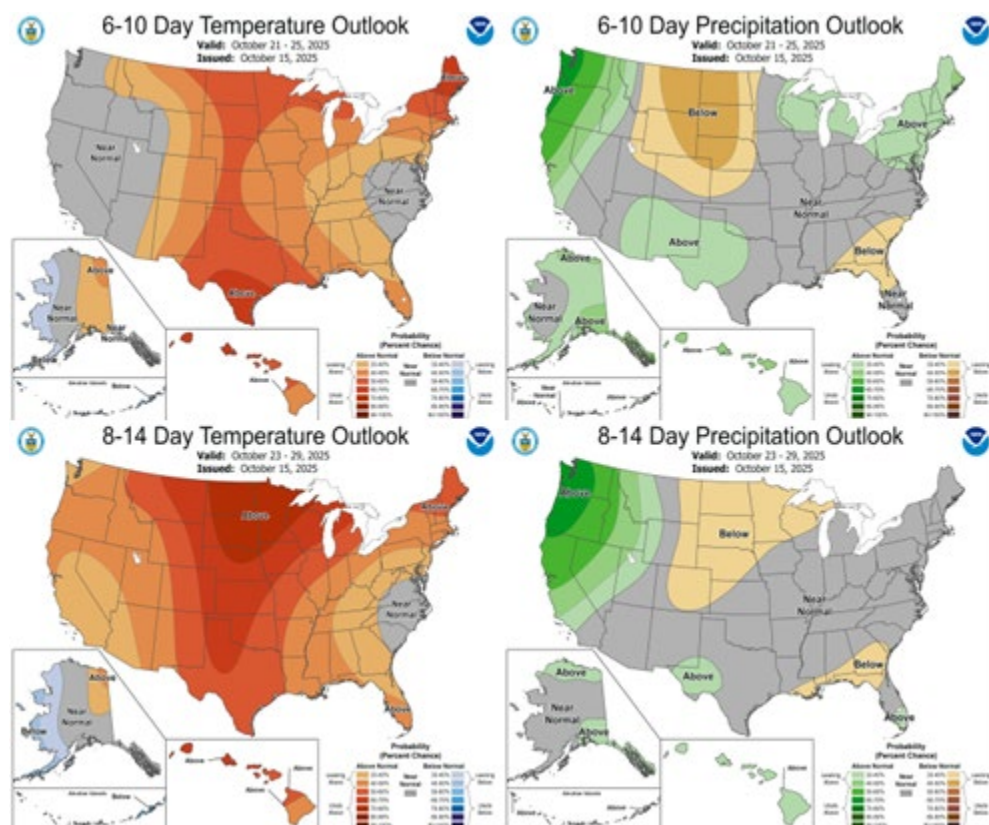
Weather Update
