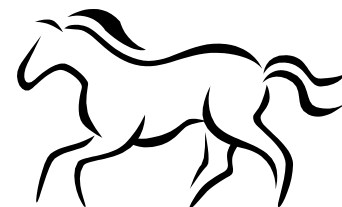




# St. Joseph County, MI 4-H HORSE COUNCIL



## Western High Point Award

- A. Award will be for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion.
- B. Points will be award from placing in Western Horsemanship, Bareback Horsemanship, Western Pleasure, Reining, Ranchmanship, Ranch Pleasure and all Western Dressage tests at the St Joseph County Grange Fair.
- C. Not all classes need to be entered to qualify.
- D. Points will be tabulated as follow: eight (8) points for first place, seven (7) points for second place, six (6) points for third place, five (5) points for fourth place, three (3) points for sixth place, two (2) points for seventh place, and one (1) points for eighth place.  
**Points are not pro-rated.**
- E. In the case of a tie, the winner be determined based on the highest score in Ranchmanship.
- F. Award may only be won once per rider/horse combination no more than once every two (2) years.
- G. Walk/Trot classes are **not** eligible for this award.
