Aligned with Next Generation Science Standards, learners investigate science phenomena taking place on the farm. Choose from a variety of opportunities for project-based learning that allow learners to make a positive difference in their world.

From plants, animals, landforms, water, and so much more, Tollgate has several amazing programs to fit any curriculum. **Here are a few of our fall favorites:**

Water and Land: The Connection -

How can we have an impact on the movement of the land? Students will use this knowledge of the nonliving parts of our earth and apply it to uncover how they are connected to the living things in an ecosystem.

Harvest Farm Ecology -

Take a wagon ride to pick a pie pumpkin at the patch, visit the orchard to explore the apple life cycle and the science of sweetness, press apples, and enjoy a harvest snack with cider. Engage with the farm animals to learn how they cope with the coming cold.

Weather and Animal Adaptations -

Help care for the Tollgate animals while you observe plant and animal adaptions to the weather. Make and use weather instruments to collect weather data on the farm and compare with measurements taken in your schoolyard.

The Secret Life of Trees:

How do trees survive and grow on the farm? What is something you observe that all trees have? What do some trees have and others don't? How are trees different from other plants and how are they the same? How do trees compete and cooperate with other trees for sun, water, nutrients to meet their essential needs? Observe and explore these and many more phenomena as you investigate the world of trees in the forest, orchard, and arboretum on the farm.
